

Trekking Gear List



BACKPACK

1 x 25–35 liter backpack or whatever size you prefer. (No smaller)

FEET

3 x trekking socks
2 x liner socks
1 x waterproof trekking boots/shoes
1 x camp shoes/sandals

HEAD / HANDS / EYES

1 x pair insulated waterproof/windproof gloves
1 x pair thermal gloves
1 x Beanie
1 x sunglasses (category 3 or 4 lenses)
1 x Sunhat (wide brim)
2 x buff (great for covering face when dusty, sun protection and over the face on summit day)
1 x head lamp (plus spare battery/bulb)



UPPER BODY

1 x soft shell/ light weight fleece jacket
1 x 800+ loft down jacket
1 x micro down jacket (synthetic or down)
1 x waterproof/windproof jacket (Goretex)
2 x mid layer long sleeve shirt – quick dry
2 x synthetic or Merino wool t-shirts
2 x thermal top

LOWER BODY

2 x trekking pants
1 x softshell pants
1 x shorts or zip-off pants (optional)
1 x windproof waterproof pants (optional)
2 x thermal bottoms



IMPORTANT ESSENTIALS

1 x pair trekking poles (optional)
1 x Gaiters (optional)
1 x travel towel (microfibre are best)
1 x small face cloth
2 x small bottles hand sanitiser (important)
1 x tube Sunscreen
1 x tube Lip balm (minimum 40 SPF)
Spare laces (important)
Camera (optional)

SLEEPING

1 x –15 to –20° celcius sleeping bag

HYDRATION

2 x one litre water bottles or 2 litre camelbak bladder. Bottles are preferred as we fill with boiling water

TRAVELLING DOCUMENTS

Passport (plus 2 photocopies of passport)
4 passport size photos
Airline tickets
Travel insurance
Wallet/Pouch for travel documents/money and passport

FIRST AID KIT

Medications / Pain Killers / Anti-inflammatory
Band-aids / Blister Pads
Ointments

OPTIONS:

You will receive an Everest One duffel bag (to keep) which will be carried by our porters on the trek (Nepal only).
